Welcome, Rev. Ronnie Hopkins...

It is with a great deal of excitement that Central Christian Church, Disciples of Christ, in Enid, Oklahoma, announces that Rev. Ronnie Hopkins will become Central's next minister, starting July 1.

Rev. Hopkins was unanimously endorsed by the Search and Call committee and unanimously voted by both the board and the congregation of Central to become their next minister. Without a doubt the board and congregation felt that God has called Rev. Hopkins to Central Christian Church.

Rev. Hopkins resides in Woodward, Oklahoma, with his wife, Lavonna, and is currently serving in the First Christian Church of Woodward. He has also served Central Christian Church in Fairview and First Christian Church of Pond Creek.

He attended Oklahoma State University and received a BS degree in 1992. He then attended Colorado State University and earned a MS degree in 1994. In 2006, he graduated from Phillips Theological

Seminary with a Master of Divinity. He was ordained into the Disciples of Christ Church on June 6, 2006 in Oklahoma.

Rev. Hopkins has been involved with the Northwest Area Disciples Ministers of Oklahoma serving as Moderator and on the Northwest Cabinet. He has also served on the Regional Board, Executive Committee, and the Regional Personnel Committee. Rev. Hopkins has served on the Worship and Spirituality Commission and is currently the Chair of the Commissioned-on Clergy. He has been involved with the local Ministerial Alliance since he arrived in Woodward in 2017, served on Kids Inc. board since 2018, has been involved with Lion's Club earning his 15-year service pin, has served on the Chamber of Commerce Board since 2022 and has done mentoring work at the since 2018.

Ronnie is looking for challenges and new things to explore. He enjoys preaching, teaching and pastoral care. He likes to meet people

where they are.
